

Top 10 Questions

- How much time is this going to take? Generally 6:30-8pm twice a month on Sundays for Bible Study; 6:30-8:30pm once a month for Fellowship; 6:30-8:30pm once a month for Discipleship Groups.
- What are we going to do with our children during group meetings? We have young children, so young families can join.
- Will there be homework? If so, how much? Not usually. In the summer we usually try to go through a book. Discussions are based on Sunday sermons.
- Am I going to have to talk or can I just sit and listen during meetings? Either is fine! We sometimes break off into groups of 3-4.
- Will I have to pray out loud? No, though we do pray at the end of every week.
- Who else is going to be in the group? Other “young professionals,” graduate students, twenty-somethings.
- How much do I have to know about the Bible? We go deep at times but try to always focus on life and following Jesus. No Bible drills involved!
- How many weeks or months is the group going to last? On and off throughout the year; we take some short breaks.
- If I don’t like it, can I leave without people being angry with me? Sure. You are welcome to come check it out.
- What are we going to do during meetings? 6:30-7pm coffee, dessert, sometimes a light meal. 7-8pm Bible study and prayer. We hang out afterwards, usually until 9pm. Monthly fellowship includes games, potluck, etc. Monthly discipleship groups meet separately (coffee shop, restaurant, etc.) to encourage and discuss life.
