Tuition Payments

Some have asked about payments for December and whether there is a full payment due. The answer is **yes**, because...

"Monthly tuition is due the 1st of each month. It is considered late after the 10th and a \$10 late fee should be added to any payment made after the 10th. In order to keep monthly payments as low as possible, tuition is based on a 7 day a week month. **When a month has more than 7 days, such as 8 or 9, we do not ask for an additional payment for those days. Instead, the school year averages out for those few months with less than 7 days, such as in December." Please know our only goal is to pay our teacher salaries, pay for lunches for your children and to purchase needed supplies.

Because of the shorter month, please make sure to get all payments in the office **on time** so that we can finish out the school year & have time to enjoy the holidays with our families. **THANKS!!!**
